

Terms of Service

Effective date: July 5, 2026

These Terms are the agreement between you and Enkaae (“Enkaae”, “we”, “us”, or “our”) for using enkaae.com and our related apps (the “Service”).

Enkaae is a small, independent event-invitation service built mainly for people in Sri Lanka. It isn’t a registered company yet — it’s run privately by the team behind Enkaae. If that changes, we’ll update these Terms.

By creating an account, ticking the consent box, or using the Service, you agree to these Terms and our Privacy Policy. If you don’t agree, please don’t use Enkaae.

1. What Enkaae is

Enkaae lets a “Host” build a digital event invitation page (for a wedding, birthday, or similar), collect RSVPs and guest details, manage seating, and add photos and music. Guests use the invitation page and RSVP form the Host shares with them.

2. Who can use it

You must be at least **18** and able to enter a contract to create a Host account. Enkaae is mainly for people in Sri Lanka; if you use it elsewhere, that’s at your own risk regarding local law.

3. Your account

- Give accurate details and keep your login private — you’re responsible for what happens under your account.
- Email **support@enkaae.com** right away if you think your account has been compromised.
- We may suspend or close accounts that break these Terms, misuse the Service, or look fraudulent or unlawful.

4. Plans and fees

- Enkaae has different tiers (currently **Free, Plus, and Premium**) with different limits on things like photo count and file size. Limits can change; the ones in effect when you upload apply.
- We don’t take payments through the Service yet. If you upgrade to a paid tier, we’ll confirm the fee and any refund terms with you directly (by email or invoice), and those terms cover that purchase.
- Any gift-registry or PayPal link you add is provided **by you, for your Guests**, and goes straight to a third party. Enkaae isn’t involved in those payments.

5. Your Guests’ information

When you add information about your Guests (names, phone numbers, emails, RSVP and meal/drink preferences), **you confirm that:**

- you have the right to collect it and share it with us to run your event (for example, their consent);
- you won't add sensitive details beyond what the event needs (e.g. keep it to a basic dietary preference, not health information);
- you'll handle any Guest request to see, fix, or delete their info, and tell us at support@enkaae.com if you need help.

You understand all Guest data is permanently deleted under section 7, and that this can't be reversed once it happens.

6. Photos, music and other content

- **You keep ownership** of what you upload ("Your Content"). You just give Enkaae permission to store and display it as needed to run your event page for you and your Guests.
- **You're responsible for Your Content**, including that:
 - you own it or have the rights to use it (licensed music, a photographer's permission for wedding photos, consent from people in the photos);
 - showing it on your event page doesn't break anyone's copyright, privacy, or other rights, or any law.
- **If a problem comes up**, you agree to cover Enkaae for claims, losses, and reasonable costs that arise from Your Content — for example, a claim that it infringes someone's rights.
- We don't check uploads in advance, but we may remove content or suspend an account we reasonably believe breaks these Terms, infringes rights, or is unlawful — including on a valid takedown notice.
- Your Content is deleted with the rest of your event under section 7.

7. Event lifecycle and deletion

This is core to how Enkaae works, so please read it:

- **Auto-deletion.** Every event and all its data (Guest details, RSVPs, seating, notes, photos and music) is **permanently deleted 3 months after the event date**, unless it's been archived. This can't be reversed.
- **Warning email.** We try to email you about a week before. It's a courtesy only — if it doesn't reach you, deletion still goes ahead. Back up anything you want to keep before your 3-month deadline.
- **Archiving.** To keep an event longer, email support@enkaae.com before the deletion date and ask us to archive it. It's manual for now; we may decline or later lift an archive (e.g. suspected abuse), with notice where we can.
- **Deleting it yourself.** Deleting an event gives you **48 hours** to undo. After that it's permanently purged. You can also force immediate deletion that skips the 48 hours — that can't be undone.
- **No obligation to keep data.** Beyond the above, Enkaae isn't required to retain or back up your data, and isn't liable for data lost through this process working as intended.

8. Fair use

Please don't use Enkaae to: upload unlawful, harassing, or infringing content; try to access accounts or systems you shouldn't; scrape or interfere with the Service; send invitations for events you're not authorised to run; or get around plan limits. We may suspend or end access for any of these.

9. Third-party links

Enkaae may link to other services (a gift-registry/PayPal link you add, or a calendar/WhatsApp share). We don't control them and aren't responsible for them — their own terms apply.

10. Our content

Enkaae's templates, designs, software, and branding belong to Enkaae (or its licensors). You get a personal, non-transferable licence to use the Service to build and share your own event page — that's it; nothing here transfers ownership of Enkaae to you.

11. No guarantees

Enkaae is provided **"as is" and "as available."** We can't promise it will always be available, secure, or error-free, or that data will never be lost — including through the deletion process in section 7 working as designed.

12. Limits on liability

Enkaae is a small, growing service. To the extent the law allows, we're not liable for indirect or knock-on losses, or for lost data, revenue, or goodwill, from your use of the Service. If we're ever found liable, our total liability won't exceed what you paid us (if anything) in the 12 months before the claim. Some rights can't be limited under Sri Lankan law, and nothing here affects those.

13. Ending things

You can stop using Enkaae and delete your events anytime. We may suspend or end your access for a breach of these Terms, or otherwise with reasonable notice where practical. The deletion rules in section 7 still apply to any events that remain.

14. Changes

We may update these Terms from time to time. If we make important changes, we'll email you or post a notice before they take effect. Continuing to use Enkaae after that means you accept the update.

15. Law and disputes

These Terms follow the laws of Sri Lanka. If something's wrong, please email **support@enkaae.com** first — we'll do our best to sort it out with you directly.
